

Scholarship for the Study of Art Application Form 2017

RECIPIENT MUST:

- Be a Fremont high school senior
- Be a Fremont resident.
- Have firm plans to include visual art classes at college level.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Provide a portfolio of artwork. Minimum 4, maximum 6 pieces. Submit samples of your work in CD form.
- Have a minimum GPA of 2.50 at time of application.
- Must provide a written letter of recommendation from Fremont high school art instructor (creativity/ability) and an unofficial transcript (GPA/school attendance/classes completed), submitted directly to selection committee.
- Have written permission of parent/guardian.
- Applicant is not required to demonstrate financial need. The award will be made on artistic merit.
- Must be available on the reception evening **May 19, 2017** from 6:00 to 9:00pm

AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP:

- First place award of \$2,000.00
- Two honorable mentions of \$1,000.00

The checks will be sent to the financial aid office of the school/college each recipient is attending, and is not renewable.

PURPOSE:

Scholarship is to be used at an accredited school/college toward visual art classes.

SELECTION:

3 recipients will be selected by **April 28, 2017**. All awards will be presented during the reception on **May 19, 2017**.

DEADLINE:

Student should complete the application and return it, with samples of artwork on a CD or thumb-drive/flash drive (clearly labeled with name, artwork type, title/description, size of work, and date completed), to the address below by the deadline of **March 31, 2017**.
