### OHAG Gift to Fremont Main Library

Brian Edwards, Division Director of Fremont Libraries, has kindly acknowledged the Guild's recent gift of \$1,000. The donation will be used to purchase books for the collection at the Juvenile Justice Center (JJC) & Camp Sweeney libraries. Brian notes that adding these books to the collection at JJC helps to expose at-risk youth to the world of art, and focuses on the positive world around them. Justice involved youth will be able to borrow these items and share them in their housing units. Here are titles of just a few of the books: (1) Art: The Definitive Visual Guide; (2) Alphabeatz. Graffiti Alphabets from A to Z; (3) Latinx Photography in the United States: A Visual History; (4) Soul of a Nation: Art in the Age of Black Power; (5) Adult Coloring Book for Good Vibes; Jean-Michel Basquiat: Crossroads. Brian adds, "Art and art education can be a powerful tool in our community."
