# GET TO KNOW OUR BUSINESS MEMBER MARIO ZUNIGA FROM BAY FRAMES

#### Q: How long has Bay Frames been in business?

**A:** I purchased the business in 2012 so it's been ten years that I've owned the business.

#### Q:How did you get interested in the framing business?

**A:** I started working for the previous owner back in 2003. At that time my Aunt was working here and they needed extra help so she asked me if I would like to learn how to do framing. I had always been good working with my hands and I had a lot of interest in the arts so I thought why not combine the two? So over the years I learned the trade and really enjoyed it. Then one day the owner decided that he wanted to sell the business and asked me if I would like to purchase it, so I jumped on it.

#### Q: What do you enjoy the most about your business?

**A:** The part I enjoy most is learning the stories behind every customer. I get to see pictures from where they have been and what they've experienced. I learn about places and things, (though I may never experience them personally,) through my customers. Also, there is a history factor. I have framed works that hold historical interest to the Tri-Cities, Bay Area, and the world.

### Q: What were your biggest challenges during the pandemic and did your business suffer because of it?

**A:** There were supply chain issues, molding for the frames, glass, backing materials, matting, those sort of things. There was a huge slowdown in business, especially during the first two months of the pandemic, and staffing issues. I had to lay off my extra workers which really hurt.

### Q: What do you want your existing and potential customers to know most about Mario's Bay Frames?

**A:** I would want my customers to know: At Bay Frames you'll receive excellent quality backed by years of experience. We can do small jobs, large jobs and anything in between. We are a one stop shop! We can Print, Frame, and Install your artwork.
