OLIVE HYDE

Engaging with paint as a daily practice helps me build my own universe. I paint colorful fantasies that incorporate shape and pattern in an abstract fashion. Using a process of layering with varying degrees of transparency, I create a world of color and abundance.

My early career as a designer for print and animation informs my approach. I spent years looking at and manipulating imagery used in children's entertainment. I apply that sense of saturated color and energy in my paintings, exploring shape, color and light in a playful way. I use water-based media to build up layers of vibrant color. Recently I have expanded my work into creating tufted tapestry. Painting with yarn has become a natural extension of my art practice and my desire to create colorful environments.

A variety of themes determine a shape of a series. Vaudeville, classic cinema, botany, and pattern design inform past themes. As I find new and better ways to express myself, the more vibrant my universe becomes.



IMPROVEMENTS IN ROSTER MANAGEMENT

While some of our members enjoy having a printed copy of our complete membership roster, we've come to realize that it's also a project requiring extra work and cost to produce and maintain – not to mention the ecological impact of that much paper! In addition, as membership details change, the print version is often rendered incomplete or incorrect soon after it's distributed.

We evaluated options for electronic distribution of our roster (such as publishing directly on our website), and that has its own concerns:

- 1. Privacy concerns: Publishing the roster publicly exposes members' personal information, which can be a violation of their privacy. There would then be a risk that information was misused by spammers, identity thieves, or other bad actors.
- 2. Safety & security risks: Publishing the roster publicly online may attract unwanted attention
- 3. Loss of control: Publishing the roster publicly means we lose control over who can access the information.

Instead of publishing the hardcopy roster as we usually due in late summer, we'll be moving to a secure, protected online version of the roster, using Google Drive. With this new implementation, we'll also be able to seamlessly keep the roster details up-to-date throughout the year. Details are still being worked out.

Help Finding Artists for the Holiday Show & Sale



OHAG SOCIAL




