I DREAM OF COLOR - JENNIFER BANZACA

Engaging with paint as a daily practice helps me build my own universe. I paint colorful fantasies that incorporate shape and pattern in an abstract fashion. Using a process of layering with varying degrees of transparency, I create a world of color and abundance.

My early career as a designer for print and animation informs my approach. I spent years looking at and manipulating imagery used in children's entertainment. I apply that sense of saturated color and energy in my paintings, exploring shape, color and light in a playful way. I use water-based media to build up layers of vibrant color. Recently I have expanded my work into creating tufted tapestry. Painting with yarn has become a natural extension of my art practice and my desire to create colorful environments.

A variety of themes determine a shape of a series. Vaudeville, classic cinema, botany, and pattern design inform past themes. As I find new and better ways to express myself, the more vibrant my universe becomes.

PROJECT MINI ART RETURNS

Project Mini Art was such a wonderful success in 2022 that we are bringing it back as part of our Holiday Show in October 2023. We will display and sell Mini Artwork by our OHAG members for \$35 each. All proceeds will go to the Scholarship fund. The guild will provide a 5" x 5" gallery wrapped canvas with a 1-1/2" profile to all artists who would like to participate. We will show up to 40 of these small pieces. All mediums that can be applied or adhered to this surface are eligible to participate, including painting, glass, collage, photography, fiber/textiles, beading, knitting, mixed media, mosaics, ceramics, and more. 2023 OHAG SCHOLARSHIP AWARD PROGRAM RESULTS

The OHAG Scholarship Awards reception was held Friday, May 19th. Each of the 7 finalists set up individual displays in the Olive Hyde Mission Room, giving attendees opportunity to meet them and view their artwork prior to the presentation of awards.

This year, 23 students applied for the scholarships. 19 students were from Ohlone College and 4 students from Fremont High Schools including American High School and Alston High School. The awards were determined by this year's jurors, Olive Hyde Art Gallery Curator, Leah Andrews, and City of Fremont Recreation Supervisor, Gloria Kim. The students were informed of the selection of finalists on May 10th.

A special award was added this year, the Jan Schafir Memorial Art Scholarship Award, in honor of longtime Guild member and lifelong artist, Jan Schafir. During the program in the courtyard, family members Paulette Schafir and Alex Schafir each spoke and offered personal tributes to their loving Mother. Mission Coffee OHAG Business Member Gael Stewart also spoke, sharing stories about her dear friend and some wonderful times they spent together setting up art exhibits at the coffee shop. Alex Schafir presented the award and also expressed their family decision to continue the Jan Schafir Art Scholarship Award for some years to come.

Next, Olive Hyde Art Guild Scholarship Program Chairs Dina Rubiolo and Edie Christensen proceeded with presentation of the Scholarship Awards. As the awards were announced each student received flowers and an award certificate.
