- COF Mission San Jose Better Block Event Over twenty Guild members participated at the Friday Night/Saturday event in the courtyard
- OHAG "Meet & Greet Social" in the Courtyard, celebrating April's Arts, Culture, & Creativity Month for members and the public
- April on The Fremont Podcast with Ricky B and Manveen Kalyanpur for "talk" about the Guild and the Gallery

Olive Hyde Art Guild Scholarships for Fremont High School and Ohlone College art students in pursuit of higher education in art

- 23 Scholarship Applications were received
- COF Jurors Gallery Curator Leah Andrews and Recreation Supervisor Gloria Kim
- A total of \$5,500 funded: one \$2,000 HS award, one \$2,000 Ohlone College award; two HS \$250 art supply e-cards and two Ohlone College \$250 art supply e-cards; \$500 to HS Art Instructor for classroom art supplies
- A special Jan Schafir Memorial Art Scholarship Award for \$750 was presented by her family
- Note: Scholarships are to be used at an accredited school/college toward the pursuit of visual arts in higher education

Serra Center Art Workshop – A Successful Collaboration with the City of Fremont, Serra Center, and Olive Hyde Art Guild

- The Guild has sponsored and funded the Serra Center Art Workshop for 13 years
- 20 developmentally disabled adults participated in the 9-week Wednesday evening classes in creative drawing and painting at the Fremont Community Center-Central Park
- COF Art Instructor Edie Christensen and Art Assistant Leah Andrews
- Guild funded \$3,400 in costs for COF community room rental, art supplies, art instructor, and art assistant

Contributions to the Wider Community

- \$1,000 to Abode Services for art related books and supplies for children's programs at Abode housing sites
- \$1,000 to Alameda County Fremont Main Library for art books in service areas including Bookmobiles, Juvenile Justice Center/Camp Sweeney, Fremont Main and Neighborhood Libraries
- \$1,000 for Ohlone College Annual Juried Student Art Awards Exhibition, including the OHAG Member's Choice Award selected by the Guild board members
- \$500 for Children's Mental Health Awareness Day Art Competition prizes: Hosted by COF Human Services Department's Youth and Family Services Division in partnership with FUSD schools, this year's theme was "My Happy Place"

2022 Holiday for the Arts, Gala, Show & Sale

- It was an awesome October comeback
- Over 60 artists participated
- Impressive results: gross artist sales plus gala ticket sales over \$28,000, up \$2,000 from last show in 2019
- Spectacular Gala night in the open Courtyard, live music, wine, beer, apps & desserts
