The de Young Open 2023 is the Fine Arts Museums of San Francisco's second triennial juried community art exhibition, featuring work by artists from the nine Bay Area counties. The show will run from September 30, 2023 through January 7, 2024 at the de Young Museum in Golden Gate Park in San Francisco. Over 800 pieces have been selected for the show from over 7,700 entries. Artworks will be hung salon-style and installed nearly edge to edge and floor to ceiling in the de Young museum's Herbst Exhibition Galleries, maximizing the number of works on view. We are pleased to announce our Olive Hyde Art Guild member artists who will have art in this show. These members are Adriane Dedic, Robyn Leimer, Denise Oyama Miller, and Farshid Namei. Congratulations to all!

Please join us on a field trip to the de Young Museum on Thursday Nov. 30. To make this work we will need drivers. Each driver will be reimbursed for gas, bridge toll and parking. Once we have a better head count and an understanding of who are members we will have the cost but right now we're guessing around \$35 per person. This covers transportation and entrance.
