Scholarships will be awarded to both Fremont High School seniors and Ohlone College visual art students.

PURPOSE:

Scholarships are to be used at an accredited college or university for the pursuit of visual arts in higher education.

High School recipient must meet the following requirements:

- Fremont high school senior with 2.5 GPA or higher,
- Fremont resident,
- Pursuing visual arts in higher education in Fall 2024,
- Attend awards reception if selected as finalist, Friday, May 17th, 6-8pm.

Ohlone College recipient must meet the following requirements:

- Visual art or multi-media/graphic art major,
- Registered Ohlone College student with minimum GPA of 2.5,
- Pursuing visual arts in higher education in Fall 2024,
- Attend awards reception if selected as finalist, Friday, May 17th, 6-8pm.

COMPLETE APPLICATION INCLUDES:

- Responses to scholarship questions,
- Portfolio of 4-6 artworks (see image formatting instructions below).
- Unofficial transcript stating GPA and completed courses,
- Written permission of parent/guardian if under 18 years old.

SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNTS:

Scholarships will be awarded to high school and college recipients separately. Each group will receive the following:

- One \$2,000 First place Award,
- Two Honorable Mention gift certificates of \$250 from Blick Art Supply.
- One \$500 award sponsored by the Project Mini Art program.

One student from the applicant pool will receive the \$1000 Jan Schafir Memorial Award. **One** \$500 Art Instruction Award will be given to 1st place High School recipients' teacher.

Award checks will be sent to the financial aid office of the school/college each recipient is attending and is not renewable.

Image title sheet: Upload a title sheet as a pdf file in the following format.

Image #, date completed, artwork title or description, size (HxWxD), medium.
