UPCOMING: MAY PROGRAM CREATING FROM THE INSIDE OUT

When the imagination is allowed to play without boundaries, it reflects itself into wonderful and numerous ways without being told how.

Karen Haughey has been an art teacher, artist, illustrator, and author for the past forty years.

She has been teaching this method of artful creativity effectively for the reluctant few, who claimed they couldn't draw stick figures, but ended up surprising themselves during the process. It's simply a creative class for the part of us that wants to explore outside the box.

Karen will begin this mini workshop by getting to know students by name, and anything else they would like to share about their personal and or professional journey.

She will then guide you through a relaxing meditation, or have you listen to a dramatic piece of classical music, such as Ride of the Valkyries by Wagner, for instance. The purpose is to activate your imagination through music before translating into color and form.

We'll each share our experience of the meditation and how it felt, or possibly what we saw, while listening to the music.

The Signature exercise.

Write your full name in cursive, or print it in block letters on drawing paper. Turn it upside down.

Now, make a design out of your signature. Without logic.

This mini workshop will be held at the **Mission Room at Olive Hyde on Tuesday May 21 from 10 to 12.** The artist will supply paper. Please bring colored pencils (recommended) or watercolors if you prefer.

The Juried Photography Show is a great opportunity for local photographers to share their artwork and see the photographs taken by others. The 29th Annual Juried Photography Exhibit is being sponsored by Fremont Cultural Arts Council, Fremont Photographic Society and the City of Fremont. The Juried Photography Exhibit is being held in conjunction with the celebration of Arts, Culture and Creativity month. The photographs selected by the panel of judges are on display on the first floor of the Fremont Main Library during library hours till Saturday, May 4th.

This is an extremely popular event in the local community.
