- OHAG Meet & Greet Social in the courtyard and Artist Talk by Suszi Lurie McFadden & Brandon Stauffer, celebrating April's Arts, Culture, & Creativity Month (ACCM) for members and the public
- OHAG booth at the ACCM Finale at the Fremont Downtown Event Center sharing visuals and information about how we serve the community
- President Manveen Kalyanpur gave a presentation to the COF April Recreation Commission Meeting, highlighting the Guild activities and our close relationship with COF

OHAG Scholarships for Fremont High School (HS) & Ohlone College students

35 Scholarship Applications were received from Ohlone College students and Fremont High School seniors

- OHAG member and oil painting artist Mitchell Neto served as Juror.
- A total of \$7,500 funded: one \$2,000 HS award, one \$2,000 Ohlone College award; two HS \$250 art supply e-cards and two Ohlone College \$250 art supply e-cards; \$500 to winning HS Art Instructor for classroom art supplies
- The Jan Schafir Art Scholarship Award for \$1000 was awarded – established for a 10-year duration by her children to honor Jan's legacy

 Two \$500 Project Mini Art Awards for HS and Ohlone College from the Guild's Annual Holiday Show & Sale Note: Scholarships are to be used at an accredited school/college toward the pursuit of visual arts in higher education

Serra Center Art Workshop – A Successful Collaboration with the COF, Serra Center, and Olive Hyde Art Guild

- The Guild has sponsored and funded the Serra Center Art Workshop for 14 years
- 20 persons with developmental disabilities participated in the 9-week classes in creative drawing and painting at Olive Hyde Art Center
- Led by art Instructor Edie Christensen and COF instructor aide Joshilyn Holmes
- A design for a large "mural" has been developed with arched sections for a creation by each artist
- The Guild funded \$2681 in costs for COF rental, art supplies, art instructor, and art assistant

Contributions to the Wider Community

- \$1,000 in Michael's gift cards to Abode Services for art related books and supplies for children's programs at Abode housing sites
- \$1,000 to Alameda County Fremont Main Library for art books in service areas including Bookmobiles, Juvenile Justice Center/Camp Sweeney, Fremont Main and Neighborhood Libraries
- \$1,000 for Ohlone College Annual Juried Student Art Awards Exhibition, including the OHAG Members' Choice Award selected by the Guild board members
- \$750 for Intergenerational Art Competition to promote Mental Health Awareness and Older American's Month: Hosted by COF Human Services Department's Youth and Family Services Division, this year's theme was "Stand Up and Speak Out"
- \$500 in Michael's gift cards to the Afghan Elderly Association, for art related supplies and equipment for elderly individuals

39th Holiday for the Arts, Gala, Show & Sale

- Over 70 artists participated in categories of Ceramics & Glass, Fiber, Holiday, Jewelry, Paintings, Photography & Paper, Sculpture and Wood
- Drawing for an original mixed media painting by featured artist Dmitry Grudsky
- A sensational Gala night in the open courtyard with live music, wine, beer, appetizers & desserts
- Impressive results: Gross artist plus gala ticket sales over \$33,000; member and sponsor donations over \$14,000; Project Mini Art netted around \$1000
