



OBITUARY: GRACE MARGARET RANKIN 1934 - 2024



Grace Margaret Rankin gently passed away on July 7, 2024.

She is survived by her sister Barbara (Gord) Wright, her brother

Jim (Barb) Carstairs, her brother-in-law Bill (Paula) Rankin, her children, John (Mary),

Bonnie, and Tom (Marie) Rankin, her grandchildren Carter Rankin, Gillian (Geoff)

Townsend, Cody Baeta, and Hannah Rankin, and her great-grandchildren Graham and

Garrett Townsend.

Grace was born in Vancouver, BC, Canada on August 19, 1934. Grace studied to be an RN (nurse). She immigrated shortly after marrying John (Jack) Rankin. Grace and Jack moved to Fremont in 1965 and raised their children in the Irvington community. Grace worked at Washington Hospital for a few years. In the early 1970s she and Jack started a Quik Stop Market in Union City, which they operated until retirement in 1988. They spent most of their retirement years as full-time RVers based in Coarsegold, CA, traveling throughout North America.

Grace was a founding member of the Fremont Art Association. Her paintings are hung on the walls of many homes and businesses. Her paintings have been shown in many galleries in California. She taught classes in Fremont, throughout the state, and around the world, including Scotland, Italy, and on cruise ships.

A celebration of life was held on September 13, 2024, at the Niles Discovery Church in the Niles district of Fremont.
