





Participants will begin by practicing techniques on specialized waterproof paper ideal for alcohol ink. Using a variety of colors and isopropyl alcohol, you'll learn to create captivating effects. Once comfortable, you'll craft your own artwork on a ceramic tile under Durba's guidance.





Supplies provided include alcohol ink paper, various colors of alcohol inks, brushes, straws for ink-blowing, gloves, isopropyl alcohol, small cups, and ceramic tiles. A \$10 materials fee per participant will cover these items. Don't miss this creative and inspiring session!





IN LOVING MEMORY OF ROBIN WORTHINGTON

It is sad news to share that Robin Worthington passed away on January 17at her home in Fremont. She was a very special lady and a dear friend to many in the Guild and Fremont community.

Robin was a distinguished journalist with the San Jose Mercury News and the Argus. She generously helped with OHAG's publicity needs. Of note, Robin wrote an extensive obituary in the SJ Mercury News for Olive Hyde after her death in San Francisco on November 2, 1987 at the age of 101.

Robin was a talented watercolor artist and a longtime member of the Roving Artists. Over the years she participated in many OHAG Holiday Shows and exhibitions at the Olive Hyde Art Gallery.

Robin is survived by her husband John and their five children, Lisa, Steve, Jane, Molly, and Nancy. With sincere condolences to the family, we shall miss her!

A memorial service will be held at St. Joseph's Church on Monday, February 24, at 11:00 AM.
