BOARD MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

- There was a discussion about increasing the stipend for the artists who lead the programs. Currently we have a budget of \$200. Treasurer, Vice President and President will consider this when making the upcoming budget for the 2025-2026 year.
- COF is getting new plastic chairs for the Mission Room which are lighter and easier to take care of since they are washable and wipeable. They may be keeping some fabric padded chairs, about 20 for the Guild's use in the office where the freezer is.
- Good coverage of the Members Juried Show - we have already sold 5 pieces
- Connie Kellogg will lead a cardmaking workshop
- We have not received too many entries from high school students for the scholarship, so the deadline will be moved to April 26th
- Apr 18th Social and Curatorial Tour – 11 AM Social (just drinks and cookies) and poster display etc, 12 noon Tour. This is a courtyard social followed by a tour of the gallery given by Leah.
- Participation in Fremont Creates Grand Finale Apr 27th -we will have a table from 11-3 at the event. We need a few people to help take shifts at the table to talk with folks about OHAG to encourage membership and participation in our events.
- We are live for online renewal now for the 2025-2026 year. The board decided to keep the nomination voting separate from the renewal and will be sending that out as an eblast message and Lisa will be taking care of the online acceptance of votes since some of these need to be recorded according to the bylaws

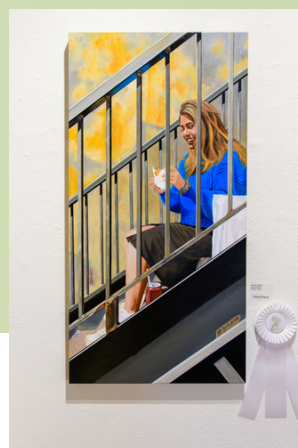

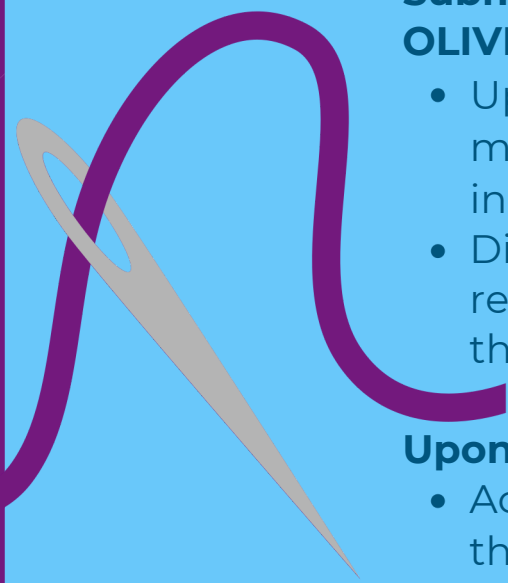

- Submit \$30 entry fee on Art Delivery Day: Friday, May 30th and Saturday May 31st from 10 AM - 2 PM.
- Accepted artwork will also be exhibited on a virtual gallery platform.

*All work must be ready to install for exhibition. Shipping fees are the responsibility of the artist.

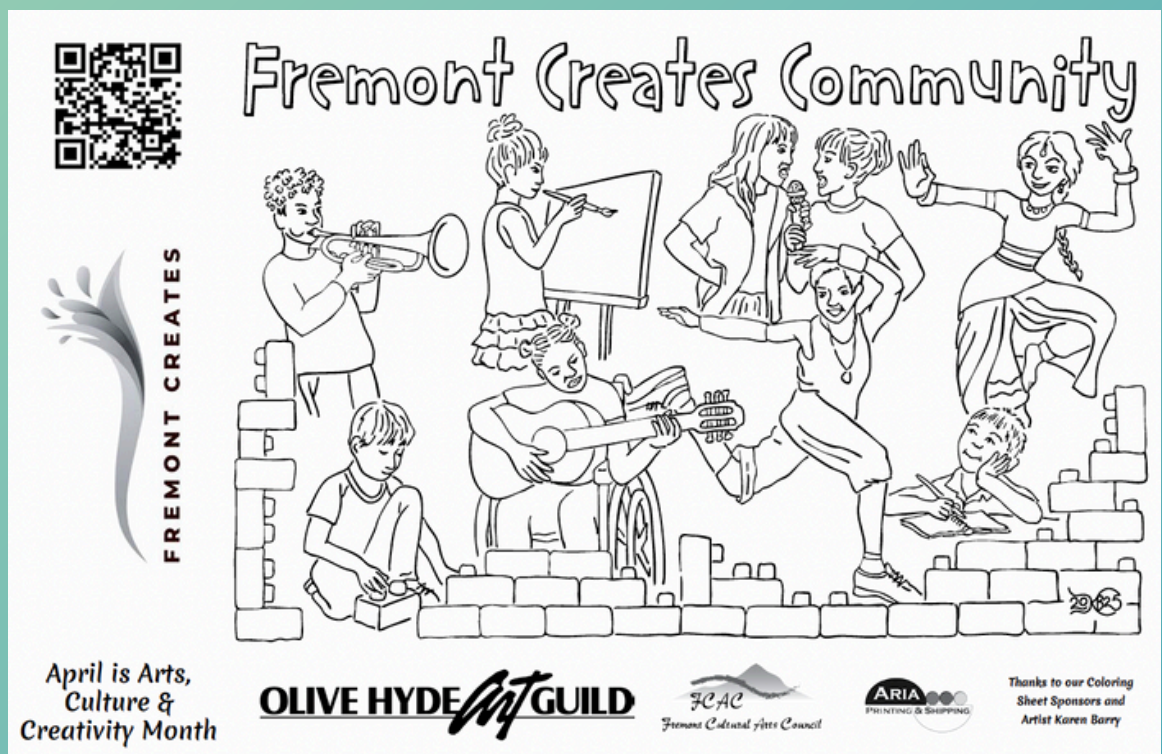

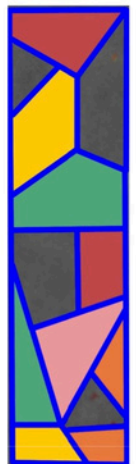
