## BOARD MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

- There will be an exhibition with FUSD and a poetry recital on November 18, 5-7 pm.
- Taylor Delacy has moved on to other opportunities. Irene Jordahl will be taking over as our COF liaison.
- Judy A. announced that OHAG's \$1,000 grant request from the Niles Fremont Rotary Club was approved to support the 2026 Holiday Show. The check was presented to Scott C. at the May 28 meeting by President Sam Forbes. All Holiday Show sponsorships are now secured. Lisa S. updated the website, bookmarks, and Call for Artists materials to include in the new NFRC sponsorship, and updated bookmarks were distributed.
- Mihika K. reported that several additional artists have signed up for the Holiday Show.
- Manveen K. presented the final 2026–27 budget proposal. Following an increase to the Serra Center allocation based on Judy's recommendation, the budget was approved by the board.
- Lisa S. reported that we have received 50 votes online. Voting closed June 1. The slate of officers was unanimously approved.

The City of Fremont's Olive Hyde Art Gallery presents Matrix: A Printmaking Exhibition, a unique showcase exploring the art and process of printmaking through works displayed alongside their original matrices.

In printmaking, the “matrix” is the surface used to create an image that is then inked and transferred onto paper or another material. Artists create these original plates, blocks, or screens using a wide range of techniques which may range from hand carving and engraving, to intricate chemical processes.

This exhibition celebrates the diversity, craftsmanship, and innovation of contemporary printmaking while offering visitors a rare behind-the-scenes look at how prints are created. Informational panels, printmaking vocabulary, and artist tools will help demystify the process and introduce audiences to this rich artistic tradition.

Featured works will include linocut, woodcut, intaglio, etching, engraving, lithography, aquatint, chine collé, collagraph, monotype, and more. Visitors also have the opportunity to purchase additional unframed print editions of displayed works.

## MAY PROGRAM: QUILTING DEMONSTRATION BY DENISE OYAMA MILLER

*On Thursday, May 28th, the Olive Hyde Art Guild hosted a highly successful art demonstration by local textile and mixed-media artist Denise Oyama Miller in the Mission Room of the Olive Hyde Art Gallery.*

*The event offered attendees a fascinating look into her meticulous "painting with scissors" technique, which beautifully converts fabric and thread into picturesque landscapes.*

*With the support of her husband, Dean Miller, Denise displayed several of her completed quilts depicting serene landscapes from her travels, including the Puget Sound and Sequoia National Park. The exhibited pieces clearly evidenced her painstaking, neat approach, love for travel and eye for natural beauty.*

*During the interactive session, Denise walked the audience through her complete impressionistic process. She demonstrated the cutting fabric of pieces in the necessary colors and layering the bits to form a cohesive landscape design based off a photograph. She then showed how she pins a sheet of tulle over the loosely placed fabric before securing it by sewing in a precise stippling pattern. The final demonstration step involved finishing the raw edges. Throughout the morning, Denise shared practical tips on the best types of fabric to use, alongside advice on essential tools and accessories.*

# SERRA CENTER UPDATE

We are thrilled to celebrate an incredible milestone 15 years of the Serra Center Art Workshop! This year, 19 inspiring artists with developmental disabilities spent 10 Wednesday evenings bringing their visions to life in the historic Olive Hyde Mission Room. Here's what COF Art Instructor Richard Clark had to say.

“When I was asked to teach the Serra Center’s 2026 Art Workshop, I felt honored and grateful for the trust placed in me –especially for the opportunity to build relationships with the disabled community over the ten-week course. As their instructor, I wanted to encourage their authenticity. Inspired by Picasso’s belief that every child is a creative genius who loses their openness when they, in order to present as more adult, pretend to know all the answers, I aimed to help these students move from striving for perfection to expressing authentic, intuitive creativity. I reminded them that such creativity dates back 10,000 years to the first cave paintings at Lascaux, France, discovered in the 1940’s, and similar drawings appear globally – in the Americas, Asia, and Australia. These artists used basic tools for mark-making: sticks, rocks, and their hands. The students soon trusted my approach and engaged with this creative play-based process, surprising themselves with satisfying results.

I am deeply thankful to the board and this remarkable community for allowing me to participate in this creative collaboration and for trusting me with this opportunity.” Richard Clark

With Richard’s encouragement, SC students created exciting works on small-size paper which were ultimately collaged and transformed into individual 18”x24” masterworks!

The Serra Center Art Workshop is a thriving success story, made possible by our partnership with City of Fremont Recreation Services and the Serra Center. As a Guild, we proudly sponsor and fully fund this program—covering instructors, art supplies, and framing to give these talented artists a vibrant space to create.

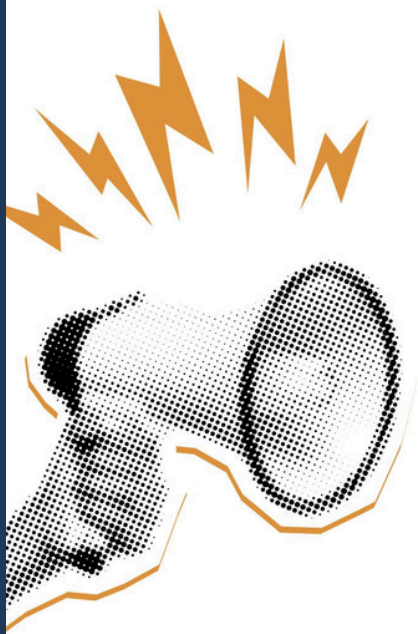
